## Notice to electors pursuant to CRS 32-1-809(1): (Transparency Notice)

(D) The Board tries to meet at least 4 times per year. WATCH POSTED NOTICES WITHIN DISTRICT FOR EXACT DATES. But generally, Sep to review district business, particularly lakes for the year, and to propose a budget; Dec to approve the budget and certify the mill levy for coming year; Feb to prepare for new year and deal with Exemption from Audit and Jun to implement year's plans. Election years may require additional dates. WATCH FOR NOTICES POSTED WITHIN THE DISTRICT.

(E) Current mill levy for 2015 is 20.194. Total ad valorem tax revenue for 2015: \$30,780.00.

(F) The next regularly schedule election date is Tuesday, May 3, 2016.

(G) Any eligible elector may submit a self-nomination form for the next scheduled election not less than 60 days before the election signed by the candidate and by a registered elector as a witness to the signature of the candidate. Said form shall be tendered to the Designated Election Official, Gerald Vargo, by email: [gerald.vargo@vargojanson.com](mailto:gerald.vargo@vargojanson.com) or to the PO Box of the District.

(H) An application to request permanent mail-in voter status can be obtained from the county clerk and recorder, or on-line from the office of the secretary of state and can be returned to the county clerk and recorder of Lake County.
